Submission Procedure

To participate in the events, we ask that by March 10, 2020, send an application and the text of the report to the organizing committee by E-mail (in the "subject" of the e-mail it is indicated: "Religion and Society 2020"). A personal invitation and an agreement form for participation in events are sent after receiving the application and the text of the report. The conclusion of the contract is a prerequisite for the inclusion of materials in the collection of the conference. The size of the registration fee will be communicated in personal information. The texts are published in the collection of scientific articles "Religion and Society - 14". Distribution of the collection approximately in June - early July 2020

Mogilev State University named after A.A. Kuleshov has the right to post materials in the electronic archive of the university library and in the Russian index of scientific citation on the platform elibrary.ru in the public domain.

Requirements for Submissions

The application and the text of the report are submitted in the form of a single document file. The file name should consist of the name and initials of the author (e.g.: V. Petrov). The application is placed on the first page of the document file. The text of the report is presented in Microsoft Word, font Times New Roman, 14pt; single spacing. All fields - 2.5 cm each. The volume of the text of the report, including a list of references - up to 3 full pages.

UDC (left alignment) is indicated on the first line of the text of the report. The title of the report is printed in lowercase letters; on the third (after skipping one line) - last name, first name, patronymic of the author (authors), then place of work and (in parentheses) - city, country (all - center alignment). Then, with a single line skip and indention of 1.25 cm, a short abstract is printed, then with a single line skip - the text of the report. References to the literature are given in square brackets. The list of literature is given at the end of the text, after skipping one line, under the heading "Literature", and is made out in accordance with GOST 7.1–2003. Alignment of text using space characters, font compression, use of automatic hyphenation are not allowed.

The organizing committee has the right to select the submitted texts. Materials in violation of these requirements that do not meet the conference topics, scientific criteria of the text, or that need proofreading, are rejected. The organizing committee does not provide information on the examination of individual works.
